COVID-19 Related Information Checklist for Parents

As the Parent/Guardian of a camper, initial each item below, indicating that you understand:

_____ All campers & staff are required to be COVID-19 symptom-free for 14 days before arriving at camp. [Symptoms as listed on the CDC website include - Fever 100.4° or higher? Chills? A new cough? Shortness of breath? A new sore throat? New muscle aches? New headache? New loss of smell or taste?] If the answer for your camper is "Yes" to any of these questions, stay away from other people, do not come to camp, and consider contacting your healthcare provider.

_____ Arriving at camp:

1. Campground opens at 1:45 PM. Camper's first event begins at 2:30 PM.
2. Upon arrival, everyone remain in your vehicle until a camp staff person gives you direction.
3. Everyone in the vehicle will be screened by answering a few questions and having their temperature taken. If ANYONE in the vehicle has a fever or symptoms of sickness, the vehicle, with all of its passengers, will need to depart the camp.
4. At the appropriate time, the camp staff person will ask the CAMPER/S to hop out of the vehicle and a counselor will help them carry their gear to the first event.

_____ If your camper gets a fever or signs of sickness during their week of camp, you will be contacted and he/she will need to be picked up as soon as possible and taken home.
